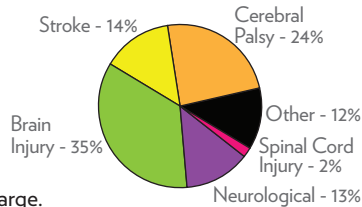
PEDIATRIC PROGRAM

- 63 patients were discharged.
- The average age of patients discharged was 6.5 years. The age range of patients admitted to the program was 10 months to 12 years. The # of patients in each age bracket was:
0 to 2 years = 8 3 to 5 years = 18
6 to 9 years = 28 10 to 12 years = 9
- Day treatment patients participated for an average of 16.9 program days. Outpatients averaged 23.5 Physical Therapy hours, 24.9 Occupational Therapy hours, and 25.3 Speech Therapy hours.
- 100% of age appropriate patients completed transition to school. 100% of those kids reached were in the same or better school placement 1 year after discharge.
- 100% of parents stated their child maintained most or all of the skills their children were discharged with at 90 day follow-up.
- 100% of school-aged children felt prepared to return to school or leisure activities.
- 5 patients were unexpectedly re-hospitalized for a short time during their rehab program.

ADOLESCENT PROGRAM

- 38 patients were discharged.
- The average age of patients discharged was 16 years. The age range of patients was 13 to 20 years. The # of patients in each age bracket was:
12 years = 1 13 to 15 years = 18
16 and older = 19

- Day treatment patients participated in an average of 15.5 program days. Outpatients averaged 30 Physical Therapy hours, 24.5 Occupational Therapy hours, and 20 Speech Therapy hours.

- 100% of patients were discharged home and 100% of those reached for follow-up were still living at home 90 days and 1 year later.
- 100% of patients completed transition back-to-school, when applicable.
- 97% of patients reached by phone remained in the same or better school placement 90 days after discharge and 100% were at 1 year.
- 100% of patients reached by phone were able to identify alternative hobbies or social activities 1 year after discharge.
- 100% of patients were satisfied with the outcomes they achieved.
- 5 patients were unexpectedly re-hospitalized during their rehab program.
